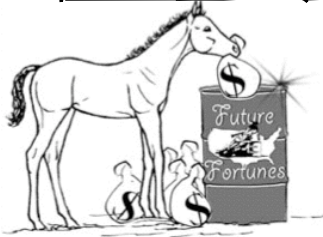

Information and General Rules

Fizz Bomb Barrel Futurity

Entry Information

\$430 Entry Fee

\$20,000 ADDED

\$105 Nomination Fee due May 1st.

Late nominations will be accepted between May 1 - 5, 2011. (\$50 Late fee if postmarked after May 5th.)

\$105 Sustain Fee due June 1st. (\$50 Late fee if postmarked after June 1st.)

\$105 Sustain Fee due July 1st. (\$50 Late fee if postmarked after July 1st.)

\$115 Sustain Fee due August 1st. Includes 2 Exhibitions. (\$50 Late fee if postmarked after August 1st.)

Payments must accompany nomination.

All payments must be postmarked on or before the due date. There will be NO Payments taken after September 10th.

NO Refunds in any CASE.

Office Charge of \$120 of total entry fee per horse ~ NO STARTING FEE. Buy Out fee of \$100.

Fizz Bomb Barrel Futurity PayOut Information

PURSE DISTRIBUTION - 25% to 1st Go-Round, 25% to 2nd Go-Round, 10% to Short-Go, and 40% to the Average.

All Late Fees & Drop Fees are retained by the committee ~ less 5% for the Amateur Division.

There will be a 3 - Run Average in the Futurity.

The 30 fastest times on the first 2 runs will qualify for the short round on Sunday.

Fastest time on 3 will win the Average.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION - 25% to 1st Go-Round, 25% to 2nd Go-Round, 50% to the Average.

All Late Fees & Drop Fees are retained by the committee.

There will be a 2 - Run Average in the Pole Futurity.

Both Runs will be on Thursday.

Fizz Bomb Barrel Futurity Amateur Division Information

NO ENTRY FEE

5% of the Total Purse will be paid out to Amateurs placing highest in the Futurity.

An Amateur is anyone who has not won over \$1000 in any Barrel Futurity Competitions.

Fizz Bomb Barrel Futurity General Rules

- ☞ The FIZZ BOMB CLASSIC FUTURITY will be supervised by our association of officers and directors and their decision will be final. We reserve the right to refuse entry to any horse or individual.
- ☞ The FIZZ BOMB CLASSIC FUTURITY is open to horses that are 5 years old or younger. (Open to horses born 2006 or later.) Horses must not have reached the age of 6 by the time of the futurity.
- ☞ All futurity horses must be checked in before competing in the barrel futurity and pole futurity. All futurity horses must be checked by our vet before competing.
- ☞ Current 30 day health papers and a 1 year Coggins required on all horses.
- ☞ To be eligible for the futurity the horse must never have competed in any barrel race for points, prizes, awards or money ~ including AQHA shows, play days, novice horse events, derbies, rodeos, etc. before Dec. 1, 2010. To do so means to forfeit all fees and elimination from the futurity.
- ☞ A copy of the front and back of registration papers or a veterinarian's affidavit of year and birth and complete physical description of unregistered horses must accompany all nominations.
- ☞ Should a nominated horse be sold during the course of the payment period ~ written authorization must be received from the original owner and \$50 change of ownership fee must be paid.
- ☞ Buyouts are allowed until September 10. The necessary papers on the substituted horse must accompany fees with a buyout fee of \$100.
- ☞ There will be a 3 run average in the futurity. The 30 fastest times on the first 2 runs will qualify for the short round on Sunday. Fastest time on 3 will win the average.
- ☞ Make checks payable to RCM Productions ~ any insufficient funds checks will be required to pay with money order or cashier's check. A \$25 fee will be assessed for ISF CHECKS.
- ☞ Fill out stall reservation form to reserve stalls, electric hook-up, or RV space. All reservations must be pre-paid. There are plenty of stalls available, you may get the stalls when you arrive in Gillette. Please check in at the stall office upon arrival and before unloading horses.
- ☞ Dress Code ~~ Long sleeved shirt, boots and hat will be enforced in the barrel futurity and pole futurity.
